Positive corona self-test at school -How to continue now:

At school

1

- The weekly corona self-tests at school are mandatory.
- If the self-test at school is positive, the affected student will be excluded from class and using the school premises by the school management.
- The school management advises the pupil or the parents that they are obliged to take a PCR test immediately.

2 The way home

- The pupil can go home independently or can be picked up by his / her parents (on foot, by bike or by car).
- Please do not use a bus, train or something similar! Contact with other people should be avoided as much as possible.

Do a PCR-Test

- The positive self-test must be checked immediately with a PCR test.
- This can be done by the family doctor or a test center. Important: Tell them on the phone beforehand that the self-test at school was positive.
- Until the result of the PCR control test is available, the affected pupil must isolate themselves at home. This means that the pupil is not allowed to have any contact with other people outside of their own household.
- Also try to avoid contacts in your own household that are not necessary and make sure to strictly adhere to the hygiene and infection protection measures. The domestic isolation of the affected pupil ends only with a negative test result of the PCR test. Only then is it allowed to take part in lessons again.
- If the PCR test is positive, the health department will take further steps in accordance with the legal provisions on infection protection.
